Primary Broadleaf Weed Control Products Used: *Amine 400 2-4-D, Trimec, Q4 Plus, 4 Speed XT*

Primary Grassy Weed Control Products Used: *Q4 Plus, Image Herbicide for Crabgrass and Nutsedge, Celsius WG*

Definition of Terms:

Nitrogen (number one in the three number set) Helps grass make the chlorophyll that gives a lawn its green color.

Phosphorus (number two in the three number set) Promotes strong root development and winter hardiness.

Potassium (number three in the three number set) Reduces loss of water through the blades, strengthens the blade, and helps the blade withstand stress and disease.

Pre-emergent Helps prevent the germination of spring and summer broadleaf weeds; helps prevent the germination of grassy weeds such as crabgrass and poa anna

Post-emergent Spray used to kill weeds after they have emerged from germination

Iron Helps grass produce its deep green color.
